

## NETPOULSAFE - WEBINAR ANNOUNCEMENT

On **June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. Central European Time (CET)** the fourth free webinar of the **NetPoulSafe project** will take place. In this webinar we will discuss about Less biosecurity measures implemented in Poultry meat production in Europe, why don't farmers implement it? and also on 2 supporting measures that can help to improve farm biosecurity measures: **participatory approach** (focus group) and **Biopon Programme**.

In the first part of the webinar, **Rozenn Souillard** (ANSES) will discuss first about the least biosecurity measures implemented in Poultry meat production in Europe, the reasons for non-implementation as well as the opinion on the effectiveness of the measures from the point of view of farmers, and advisors.

In the second part of the webinar **Nathalie Rousset** (ITAVI) and **Aitor Devesa** (CECAV and CESAC) will explain how to improve farm biosecurity through two successful SMs in their two countries: **participatory approach** (focus group) and **Biopon Programme** respectively.
